For our track to be for the younger and older racers. The whole family is welcome to come watch and enjoy a safe fun night at the kart track with lots of excitement.*

*Safety is important to us and we would like to see everyone have safe clean fun. That the future of kart racing is with the kids. That teaching them from the start to watch out for each other and to drive clean you can still be a outstanding kart racer. We want to see kart racing to get better as the years pass and to see new and returning faces each year.*

### **SAFETY IS # 1**

*Watching out for our selves and each other is the way to go. We know that this is a family sport and our family has always enjoyed it as a family. We hope your whole family comes and enjoys kart racing with us. Come and join our race family.*

## Richmond Kartway Rules

### Track Rules

- 1) No driving in the pits. If you drive your kart through the pits you will be disqualified. We need to remember the kids will be in the pits.
- 2) No alcoholic beverages. If you are found with alcohol you will be asked to leave for the night. We stick to this.
- 3) No foul language. This is a family track.
- 4) No one in the staging area but the driver and one other person.
- 5) No climbing, standing or sitting on any track barriers. Such as fences, tires etc.
- 6) If you are at the track alone with young children please inform the person when you sign in your kart. This in case of an emergency no children will be left alone at the track. We can call the emergency number on your driver's card for the children. This is a courtesy to our drivers.
- 7) There will be no fighting tolerated. If you are involved in a fight you will be asked to leave. You could be suspended from the track for two weeks.

### Driver Rules

- 1) Driver changes can be made after qualifying. Only when the tower and track officials are duly informed. When this happens, kart has to start on the tail of the field. Failure to notify tower and officials will disqualify kart and driver.
- 2) New karts or drivers can have their kart, safety equipment, driver's apparel checked and the kart and driver weighed as a courtesy.
- 3) No mirrors allowed whether mounted on the helmet or the kart.
- 4) No radio/communication equipment may be onboard with the driver. No communication with driver except pit board and hand signals.
- 5) No arm restraints or helmet restraints will be allowed.
- 6) The 2008 season will start with first come first choice on kart numbers. If you would like to sign up your number at practice you will be able to do this. Please see Mark or Tina Berryman.
- 7) Your driver's information sheet must be turned in before you will be allowed to race.
- 8) Numbers must be big enough to see and must be in color contrast with kart body color.

### Kart Rules

- 1) No treaded tires.
- 2) No tire rules.
- 3) Kart weights must be painted white and kart number painted on each weight.
- 4) You may run with or without silence mufflers.
- 5) **LIMITED MODIFIED**> Aluminum Flywheels only.
- 6) **OPEN**> Aluminum Flywheels only.
- 7) **STOCK APPEARING**> Flywheel is not a tech item, unless it is a 3 H.P. Aluminum, this flywheel is **NOT SAFE AND WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.**
- 8) You may run either Stock Briggs rod or the After Market Replacement rod as long as the rod meets stock requirements. The length being 3.875 A.R.C. Burris or Horstman rod.

### Safety

- 1) Fire extinguisher for alcohol: Dry Chemical or Foam.
- 2) Novice or beginner drivers will mark rear number plate with a number followed by an "X" for 3 races and will automatically start on the tail of the field.

- 1) Jr. Sportsman Purple Plate : Age 8-14 : 250 lbs.
- 2) Jr. Sportsman Blue Plate : Age 8-14 : 275 lbs.
- 3) Jr. Sportsman Gold Plate : Age 8-14 : 300 lbs.

**LESS JR. CLASSES MAY BE COMBINED AND RUN TOGETHER DEPENDING ON THE NUMBER OF ENTRANTS.**

**NOTE: When combined Purple, Blue, and Gold wins respective class.**

- 4) Jr. Non-Restricted : Age 8-15 : 330 lbs.
- 5) Limited Modified : 350 lbs.
- 6) Stock Lite : 330 lbs.
- 7) Stock Medium : 350 lbs.
- 8) Stock Heavy : 375 lbs.
- 9) Stock Super Heavy : 400 lbs. ( Driver must wieght 200 lbs. )
- 10) Stock Appearing : 350 lbs.
- 11) Stock Senior : Age TBA : 375 lbs.
- 12) Open : 350 lbs.
- 13) Blue Motor: TBA

No Live Axels, 1 Wheel Pull Only

Fuel is Gasoline

Engine Kill:

- >On Steering Wheel
- > Spark Plug Wire

Maximum size tire is 6 inches

Brakes must be operational

Mandatory:

- > Helmet
- >Neck Brace
- > Gloves
- >Long Sleeve Shirt / Jacket
- >Socks and Shoes
- > **NO** open toe shoes

Number on:

- > Front
- > Left Side
- > Rear
- > Right Side ( Optional )

Number At Least 4 inches

Muffler or Header is Optional

No open engines. Stock length rod, stock carb. This class is a beginnersclass and will be watched closely due to safety constraints.

## Yard Kart 1

Any 5 HP Engine

- > Briggs
- > Tecumseh
- > Kohler
- > Honda

As long as the governor is operational

Fuel is Gasoline

Engine Kill:

- > On Steering Wheel
- > Spark Plug Wire

Tires must be 6 1/2 inches or larger.

Brakes must be operational

Mandatory:

- > Helmet
- > Neck Brace
- > Gloves
- > Long Pants
- > Socks and Shoes
- > **No** open toe shoes

Numbers on:

- > Front
- > Left Side
- > Rear
- > Right Side ( Optional )

Numbers at least 4 inches.

Muffler or Header is optional
